Operating Procedure Goals

Online Competitor Registration

- **Competitor will register for the tournament by completing and submitting the online form that will be published in the tournament information packet.**
- **All competitors will be required to register online by a specific deadline.**
- **The information that will be entered will include:**
 - Name
 - Home address
 - Phone number
 - Email address
 - Date of birth
 - Gender
 - Rank
 - Estimated weight
 - Club affiliation and instructor
 - USA Judo/USJA/USJF membership number and expiration date
 - Waiver and liability release acknowledgement

Remote Weigh-Ins

- **Competitors will be required to weigh-in at their affiliated club. A competitor will weigh in clothed and without shoes.**
- **The head coach will be required to submit official weighs by email to Wahadachi tournament officials by 9AM on the Friday prior to the tournament. No late entries will be accepted.**
- **The information that will be submitted by email, one competitor entry per email, will include:**
 - Competitor name and weight
 - A photo of the competitor's membership card (USA Judo, USJA, USJF) and weight as presented on a scale. See the below example.



Tournament Day Competitor Check In

- **All competitors will be required to check-in with tournament officials between 8am and 9am on the day of the tournament.**
- **The tournament official will confirm the competitor's name and weight, clothed and without shoes. Weight will be confirmed within 5% of submitted weight. If a competitor is outside of the 5% limit, they will be moved to the appropriate weight class**
